

RESOLUTION 90-2

TWIN RIVERS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION
AS TRUSTEE FOR THE TWIN RIVERS COMMUNITY TRUST

EMERGENCY VEHICLE PARKING

At a meeting of the Twin Rivers Homeowners Association, as Trustee for the Twin Rivers Community Trust, which was duly scheduled and held on March 8, 1990, on a motion made and duly seconded and thereafter unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Twin Rivers Community Trust are charged with and have the obligation of and responsibility to enforce the provisions of the Trust documents; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish such obligations, the Trust Documents provide the Trustees with various powers and authorities to make and promulgate rules and regulations regarding the conduct of the beneficiaries upon the Trust lands; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Twin Rivers Community Trust recognize the valuable service, dedication and assistance which the East Windsor Rescue Squad and Fire Company No. 2 provides to the residents of East Windsor Township and specifically the beneficiaries of the Twin Rivers Community; and

WHEREAS, the East Windsor Rescue Squad and Fire Company No. 2 have requested the support of ordinances authorizing the Township Police to issue summonses to vehicles which have been illegally parked by non-designated members of the Rescue Squad and Fire Company No. 2 in designated emergency vehicle parking places within the Twin Rivers development.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Trustee, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by the Trust Documents, hereby promulgates and adopts the following:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Township Police of East Windsor are hereby authorized to issue summonses to any and all vehicles illegally parked in certain designated emergency vehicle parking places within the Twin Rivers development, if those vehicles do not belong to active members of the East Windsor Rescue Squad and Fire Company No. 2 and do not have displayed on the said vehicles identification designating them as members of the said voluntary organization.
